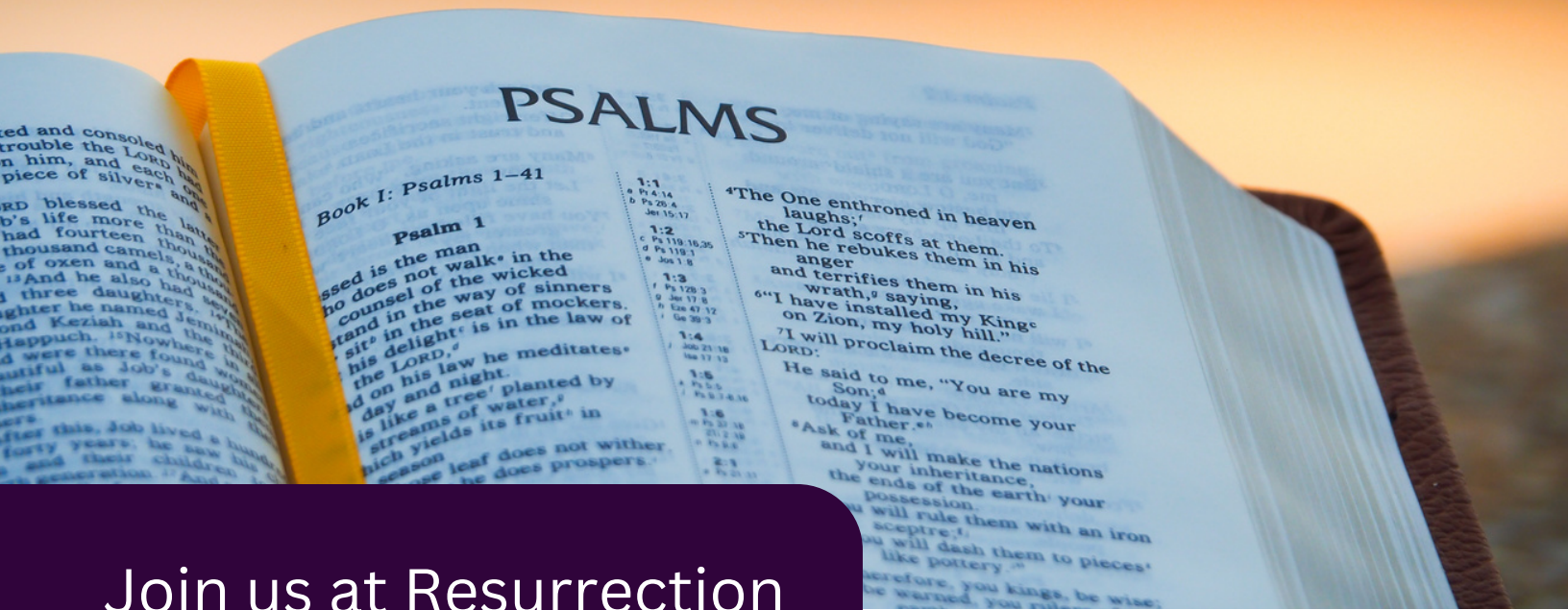
Warm Welcome Coalition Centre Support needed for Warm Welcome Centre
