



SACRAMENT PREPARATION

Baptism

During the third, fourth and fifth Sundays of Lent, all attending 9:00 am Mass will be present for the Scrutinies.


THE SCRUTINIES are special rites that help prepare the **RCIA** Elect to enter the Catholic Church — and are for all Catholics seeking to live a life of continuous conversion.

The purpose of the Scrutinies is to work in the hearts of the Elect to:

- *uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful* and
- *strengthen all that is upright, strong, and good.*

In this weekend's gospel we hear about Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead, where He reveals Himself as the Resurrection and the Life.

May we all bear witness to new life in Christ like Lazarus, who received the Resurrection and the Life.



