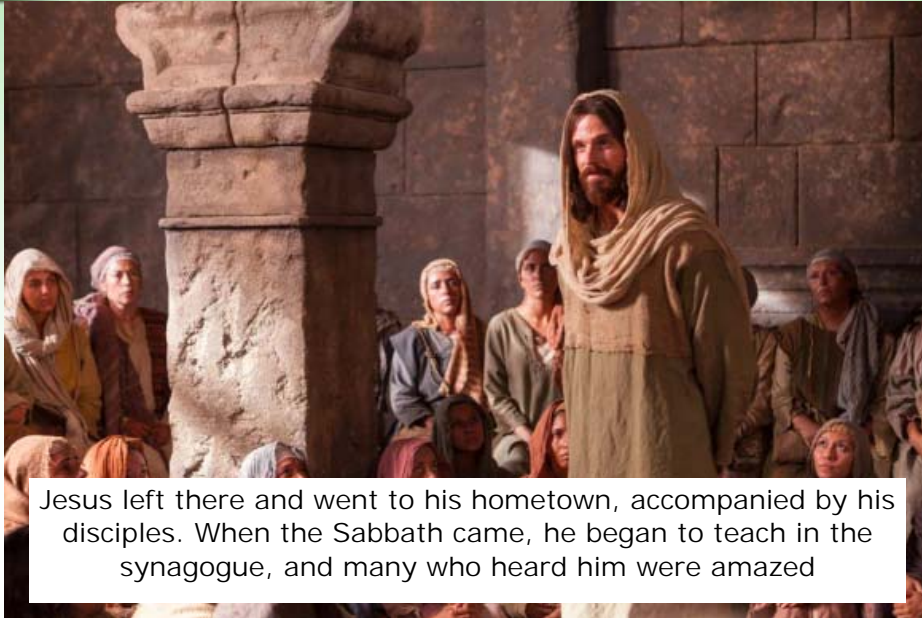

SACRAMENT PREPARATION

Baptism Registration for children under the age of seven is ongoing

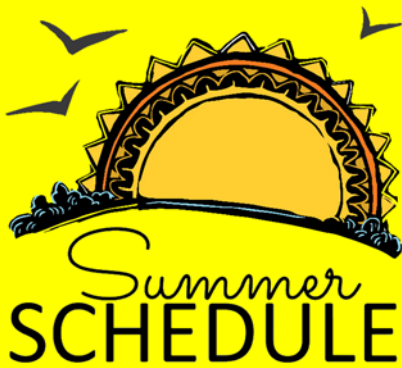

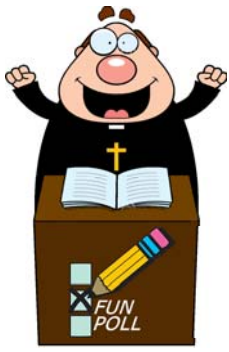
