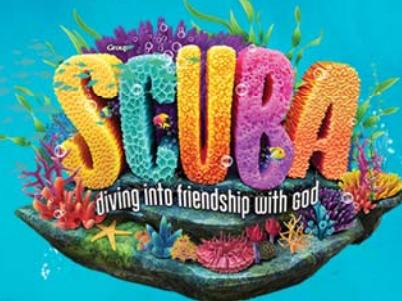

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is a Montessori based faith formation program for children. **This summer, July 2-7 this national formation course will be offered here in Regina at Holy Rosary Cathedral.** In Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, adults are given the opportunity to embrace a method of catechesis (or religious education) that will deepen one's relationship with God. Catechist formation in Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is both instructive as well as experiential. It captivates both the head as well as the heart. It has a holistic approach for the adult, enriching the adult in a background of scripture and liturgy, theology and prayer, as well as the pedagogy of the young child, helping the adult to see what face of God the young child most needs in order to enter into a relationship with God.

Therefore, Catechesis of the Good Shepherd requires the adult to receive training in the method in a way that is "retreat-like," giving time and space to absorb the richness of what it means to live one's baptismal covenant and grow in the love and knowledge of God. 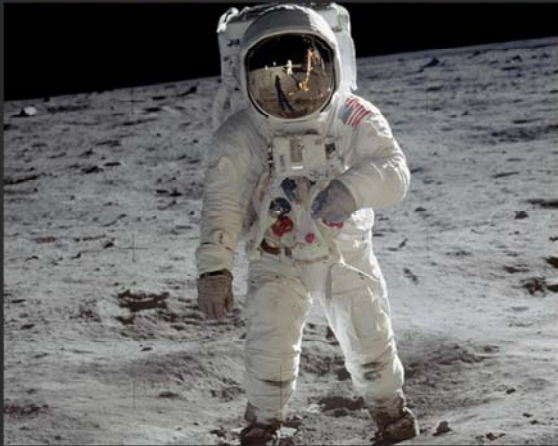
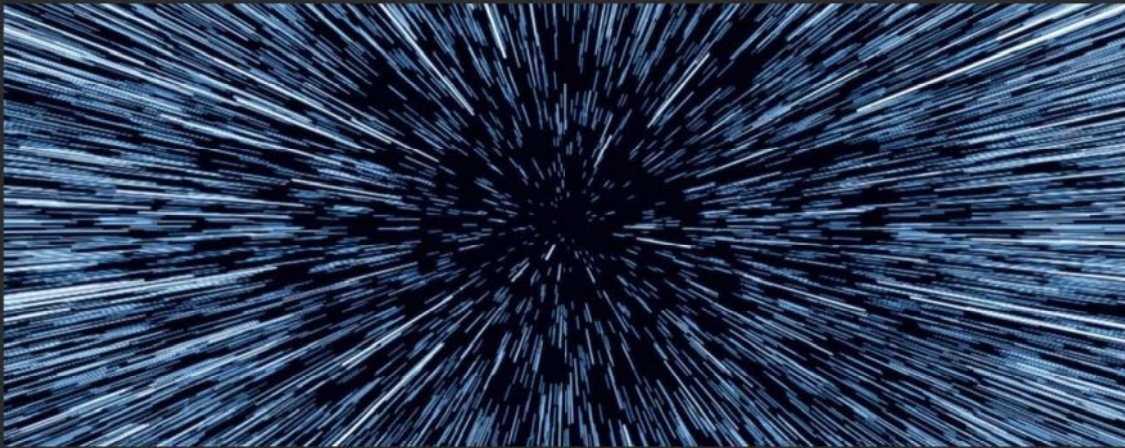

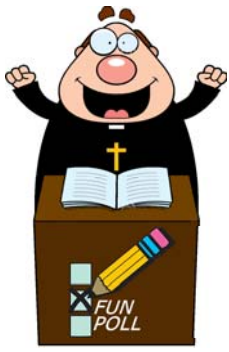
